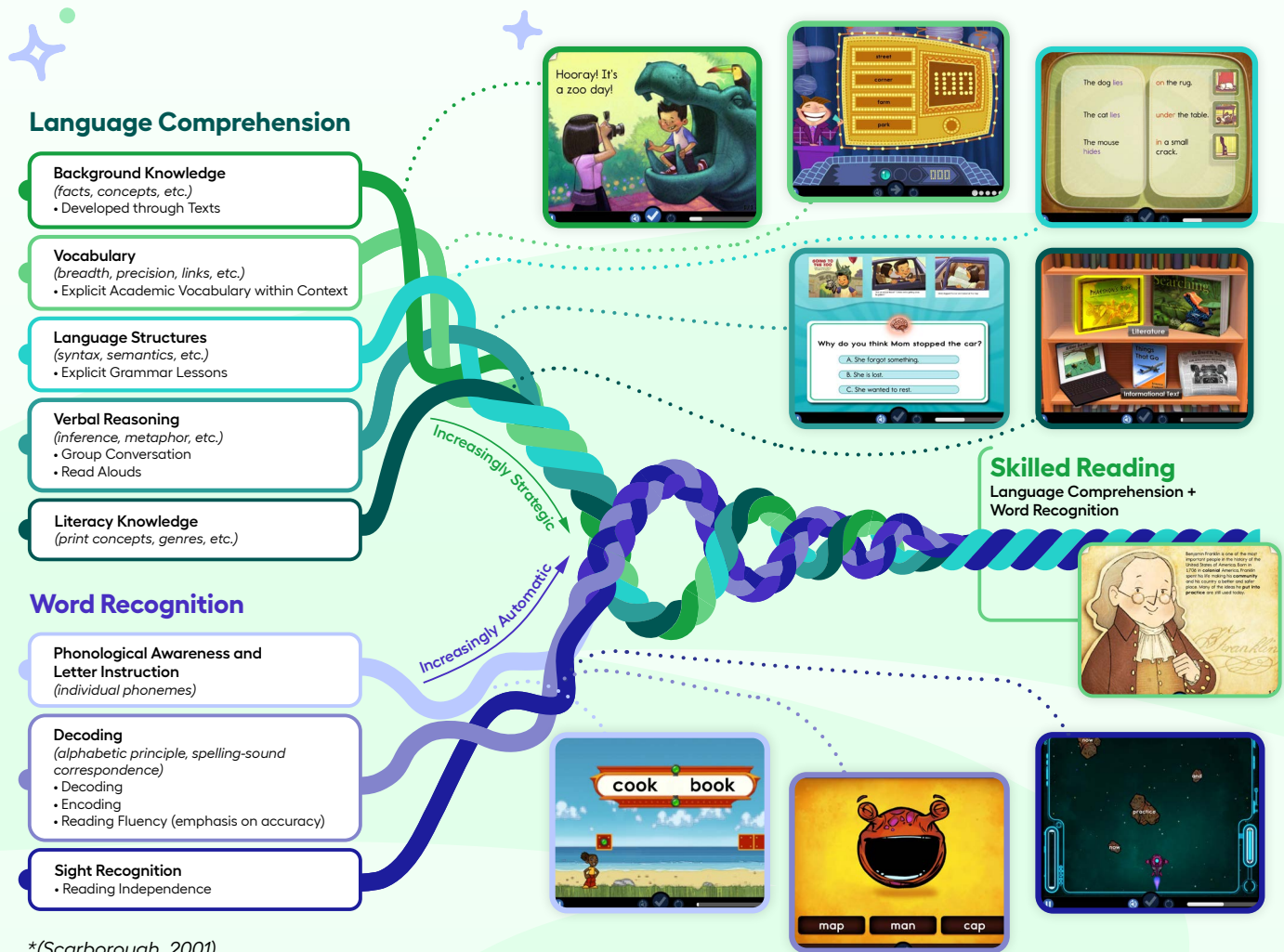


# Develop Skilled Readers
