Modules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>Unit tiles</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Each Unit has its own tile which holds all components of the EL Education curriculum for that Unit.</li></ul></li><li>● <b>Module Overview tile</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Includes a description of the Module and the Module Overview Video tile.</li><li>○ All high-level Module information is organized in a series of drop downs.</li></ul></li><li>● <b>Module Assessments tile</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Performance Task Overview and resources</li><li>○ All Unit Assessment Overviews, checklists and assessment materials</li></ul></li></ul>
Units	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>Unit Overview drop down</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ All high-level Unit information is organized in a series of drop downs.</li></ul></li><li>● <b>Digital Materials for the Unit section</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ These materials are designed to be assigned to students at the beginning of every Unit.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ Digital Vocabulary Log</li><li>■ Digital Independent Reading Journal</li></ul></li></ul></li><li>● <b>Daily Lessons tile</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Each Unit has a set of Daily Lessons. This tile holds all components of the EL Education curriculum for each lesson.</li></ul></li><li>● <b>Homework Resources section</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ All Homework resources collected in one place. They are provided in English, Spanish, and digitally.</li><li>○ The Module Overview video is also located in Unit 1.</li></ul></li></ul>



Daily Lessons	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>Daily Lessons tiles</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Each Lesson has its own tile. This tile holds all components of the EL Education curriculum for each lesson.</li></ul></li><li>● <b>Mid and End of Unit Assessment tiles</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ These are designated by the purple tiles.</li><li>○ Each Assessment tile has a Daily Lesson and the digital version of the assessment, separated.</li></ul></li></ul>
Lesson Plans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>Lesson Plan tab</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ This is the Lesson Narrative organized in manageable learning pieces. This is organized in visuals for students (Cards) and Teaching Notes.</li><li>○ Lesson Plans include digital activities for students to complete during the lesson. These align with student materials found in the Materials tab.</li></ul></li><li>● <b>Materials tab</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ A list of all materials used by teachers and students in the Lesson.</li></ul></li><li>● <b>About this Lesson tab</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ A description of the content and literacy learning in the lesson.</li><li>○ The Lesson Narrative</li></ul></li></ul>
