Strategic first-language audio support in 20 languages that enables cross-linguistic connections

As students become more proficient in English, first-language support is strategically withdrawn to gradually transition them to independence. Imagine Language & Literacy also addresses English sounds *not* found in a student's first language (e.g., the /sh/ sound in English, which is not found in Spanish).

Specialized activities based on the student's first language

We deliver instructions and corrective feedback in a student's primary language — the fastest path to understanding.

- Phonemic awareness activities: students learn to recognize sounds from their first language that are also used in English, plus sounds found in English but not in their first language.
- Activity instructions: initially provided to students in their first language. The next two times, they have the option of hearing translated instructions. After that, all instructions are given in English.

Language instruction infused into daily activities

- Vocabulary introductions: new vocabulary words are initially translated into their first language with a student-friendly definition before teaching them the new word in English.
