Word Awareness	recognizing individual words in a spoken language	Onset-rime
- What is the last sound in "chip"? - Say /ch//i//p/. What is the word? - Say "chip." What are the sounds in chip? - Say "chip." Take away /ch/, add /l/. What is the word?	Say the sentence and clap for each word: When will the dog run?	- Say "fan-tas-tic." What is the word? - Say "fantastic." Say and clap for each syllable.
a word or part of a word with one vowel sound	Syllables	recognizing individual words in a spoken language
Phonemes	words that contain more than one free morpheme (base word)	sound(s) before the vowel - vowel+following sounds
- Say /f//ish/. What is the word? - Say "fish." Take away /f/, add /d/. What is the word? - What is a word that rhymes with day?	- Say "rainbow." What are the smaller words in rainbow? - Say "rainbow." Take away "rain." What is left?	Compound Words
